The final points have been tallied and the standings are as follows:

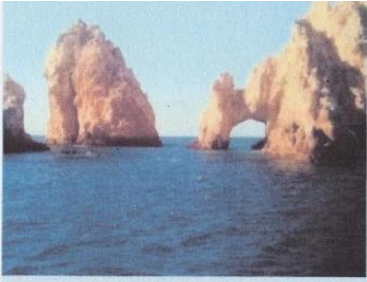
1<sup>st</sup> place: Alice Marrow, 121.5 points

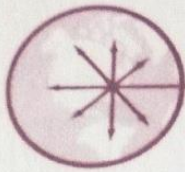
